

# Call for Nominations

## *Jane Stallings Student Service Award*

### **What is the purpose of the award?**

This award was established by the College of Education and Human Development's Dean's Development Council with the dual purpose of honoring Texas A&M University's first female dean, Jane Stallings, and recognizing an outstanding senior education undergraduate student who has demonstrated exceptional service and commitment to the teaching profession.

### **Who is eligible?**

Eligible students must have the following characteristics:

- Exhibit dedication, perseverance, courage, humility, outstanding service and a passionate commitment to children, as characterized by Jane Stallings
- Achieved senior undergraduate classification (defined as having completed 90 hours at the time of nomination) and be in good academic standing at time of nomination
- Completed more than half of their degree requirements at Texas A&M University
- Exhibit exemplary conduct record while enrolled in the College of Education and Human Development
- Freely and enthusiastically have given time and energy above and beyond the regular school requirements in the area of service, as related to the health, education and well-being of children

### **What should nomination packets include?**

1. Completed nomination form (attached)
2. Student's resume
3. A letter of nomination
4. No more than five (5) letters of support from faculty members, students and/or any supervising faculty outside the Texas A&M University System.

### **When will the award be presented?**

The honoree for the Jane Stallings Student Service Award will be recognized at a date and time to be determined. They will receive a certificate and a \$1,000.00 cash award. The student recipient will be notified as soon as arrangements are made for award presentation.
