Guidelines for the Dean's Development Council Outstanding New Faculty and Extraordinary Service Awards

Outstanding New Faculty Award:

Open to all **new** faculty members who have been employed in the college for a period of three years or less prior to the nomination deadline (if you have any questions regarding a specific nominee's eligibility, please contact Wendy Kreider at wkreider@tamu.edu or 979-845-6411). Nominees must show outstanding contributions in the areas of teaching, research, and service. Significant professional contributions to the College of Education and Human Development (CEHD) programs and departmental activities should also be evident.

Extraordinary Service Award:

Open to all College of Education and Human Development (CEHD) faculty members. Nominees must demonstrate an extreme commitment and must have gone "above and beyond" their expected responsibilities in serving their constituents, community, colleagues, and students. This award will be given only when the selection committee deems that a nominee has truly exceeded the expected level of service.

Faculty, staff or students in the CEHD can submit nominations. Nomination packets may **not** exceed ten pages and should include a nomination form, a CV/resume, a nomination letter, and one support letter (letters may **not** exceed two pages).

Nomination packets are due to **Wendy Kreider, 802F Harrington Tower / Mail Stop: 4222** or via email at wkreider@tamu.edu by **Friday, May 24, 2019**. Only complete nomination packets will be forwarded to the selection committee for consideration.

Each award winner will receive a \$1000 check and a certificate at the ***Fall Kick-Off Luncheon*** to be held on **Wednesday, August 21, 2019** in the Memorial Student Center/Bethancourt Ballroom on the Texas A&M University campus.
