



Guidelines for the Dean's Development Council Awards:
Outstanding New Faculty
and
Extraordinary Service

The following guidelines will be adhered to in determining the recipient of these two award categories:

Outstanding New Faculty Award:

1. Open to all **new** faculty members who have been employed in the college for a period of three years or less prior to the nomination deadline (if you have any questions regarding a specific nominee's eligibility, please contact Wendy Kreider at wkreider@tamu.edu or 979-845-6411).
2. Significant professional contributions to the College of Education and Human Development (CEHD) programs and departmental activities that clearly warrant recognition should be evident.
3. Please cite specific examples, in nomination letter as well as support letters, where the nominee has demonstrated such contributions in:
 - a. Teaching
 - b. Research
 - c. Service

Extraordinary Service Award:

1. Open to all College of Education and Human Development (CEHD) faculty members.
2. Nominees must have gone "above and beyond" their expected responsibilities in serving their constituents, community, colleagues, and students. This award will be given only when the selection committee deems that a nominee has truly exceeded the expected level of service.
3. Please cite specific examples, in nomination letter as well as support letters, where the nominee has demonstrated such "above and beyond" contributions in:
 - a. Teaching and research
 - b. Service to constituents, community, colleagues and students

Faculty, staff or students in the CEHD can submit nominations for the **Outstanding New Faculty** and/or the **Extraordinary Service** awards. Nomination packets may **not** exceed **twelve pages** and must include a nomination form, a CV/resume, a nomination letter, and at least one support letter (letters may **not** exceed two pages).

Nomination packets are due to **Wendy Kreider, 802F Harrington Tower / Mail Stop: 4222** or via email at wkreider@tamu.edu by **Friday, June 12, 2020**. Only complete nomination packets will be forwarded to the selection committee for consideration.

Each award winner will receive a \$1000 award placed into the recipient's professional development account at Texas A&M University and a certificate at the **Fall Kick-Off Luncheon** to be held on **Wednesday, August 18, 2021** in the Memorial Student Center/Bethancourt Ballroom on the Texas A&M University campus.
